TITLE: Know Your Place
SCRIPTURE: Matthew 18:1-9

OPENING PRAYER

ICE BREAKER: SHARE A HUMBLING MOMENT. NOT THE REALLY HUMBLING ONES.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Read the scripture for today

1. How do we fall short of God's glory? Romans 6:23
2. Read 1 Corinthians 1:26-29. What does this say to us about pride?
3. Can you remember an example of pride going before a fall in the Old Testament? New Testament? (Clue: Peter and Nebuchadnezzar)
4. Why is temptation for us now necessary?
5. Is giving into temptation inevitable? Read 1 Corinthians 10:12,13.
6. How important is not creating obstacles for those that believe in Him to Jesus? How important is it to you?
7. What is the difference between humiliation and humility?

APPLICATION

1. What is your nagging unanswered question?
2. What did you want to hear that you didn't hear from the message?
3. How can we get to know God as He is and not in the limited way we do now?
4. Think about what most caught your attention in the text or discussion. Why is God catching your attention with this at this point in your life? What does God want you to know or do?
5. What's one thing from this text that you could say to a believer/unbeliever about who God is?

PRAYER

Ask people for specific prayer requests. Pray for needs and for applications of the text. Ask for volunteers who would like to pray for those people and requests.

SHEPHERDING

Check the roster and see who is not there. Does the group know why someone is not there? Are there needs that can be met by the group? Specific prayer requests? Ask for someone to reach out and say, "We missed you."

MONTHLY MEMORY VERSE FOR DECEMBER:

Isaiah 46:4 – Even to your old age I am he, and to gray hairs I will carry you. I have made, and I will bear; I will carry and will save.
