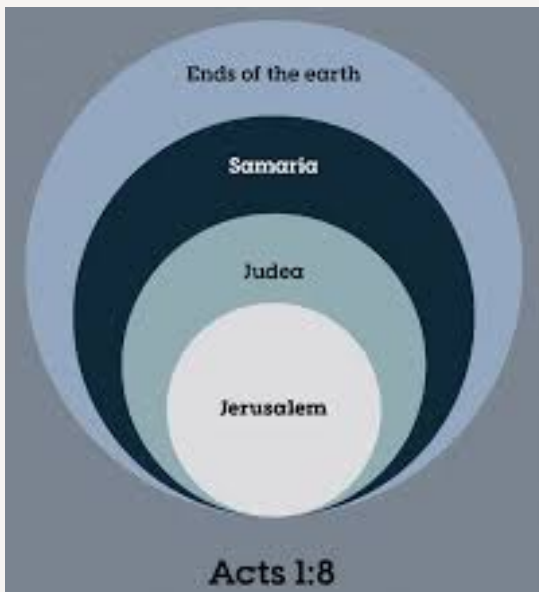
THE VISION

Go and make disciples...

Dear Church Family,

The mission of Faith Community Church is to make disciples who plant the church. This mission is not unique to FCC, but is the mission of every New Testament Church. I can say that because our mission statement is a restatement of the Great Commission given to us by the Lord Jesus. That means here at FCC, we are a Great Commission people.

The Great Commission in its most common form is seen in Matthew 28:18-20, but it shows up in various forms in all four of the gospels (Mark 16:15; Luke 24:47-48; John 20:21). It also shows up in the book of Acts. In Acts 1, as the resurrected Jesus is about to ascend into Heaven, he tells his disciples, *"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."* Our job is to make disciples by bearing witness to the resurrected Christ in the power of the Holy Spirit. But notice the locations Jesus lists: Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and to the ends of the world. In other words, Jesus tells his disciples to start where they are at and then work their way out to the whole world.



My desire is that FCC would recommit ourselves to the mission of evangelism and discipleship starting right here with our own church. This is our Jerusalem. This has been a particular focus of mine since I arrived. I have asked each of the leaders on our Ministry Team to "sharpen the gospel edge" of every one of our ministries. Please don't misunderstand me, I have every intention of engaging our community with the gospel and I am fully committed to foreign missions, but evangelism and discipleship start at home. I want it to be that no one who comes to Faith Community Church can ever say, "They never told me about Jesus."

And now, God in his providence has provided us with an incredible opportunity. Sonshine Learning Center has announced that they are moving to their new building in town. Our plan is to leverage this vacated space to revamp our discipleship for all ages. In the Fall, we will be starting a brand-new Sunday School period at 10am between the two morning services. Our worship service times will change; first service will be at 8:30am and second service will be at 11:00am. The Sunday School period will have classes available for all ages (including adults).

During the worship services, there will be Children's Church available for children 4K-1st grade, and nursery services will still be provided. Children in 2nd grade and older will remain in worship with their families for the whole service. Keeping these older children in the worship service is intentional. One of the unintended consequences of removing older children from the worship service is that they begin to believe that "big church" is "boring church." We want to incorporate them in the worship of the church as soon as possible so they can grow in Christian maturity.

In order to make this vision a reality in the Fall, we will need your help. This month, we are beginning a project we've given the name of "Faith Rebuild." This plan will begin with a kickoff on July 26-27th in which we will be assisting Sonshine in their move across town to their new facility. Sonshine is led by two wonderful members of our church, Todd and Haley Hennlich, and we want to bless them and love them well as their business flourishes in their new location. Our next goal will be to spend the month of August renovating that wing of our building, as well as the kitchen, for our ministries to utilize in the Fall.

You can help by praying, serving and giving.

- **Pray:** First and foremost, we recognize that we can achieve nothing on our own. If the Lord is not in this plan, it will not succeed. Will you regularly pray that the Lord would bless this work as we seek to serve Him?
- **Serve:** Second, we will need teams of volunteers working on the building throughout the month of August that will be directed by the Board of Trustees. (There will be more information coming out about this soon.) Will you join us in renewing and rebuilding the "E-Wing" (Education wing) for ministry?
- **Give:** Finally, you can give online to Faith Rebuild by going to our website. Would you consider how the Lord may be calling you to financially contribute to this cause?

I am so thrilled to be a part of Faith Community Church and I look forward to what God is going to do in the future!

- 8:00am: Devotion and breakfast at FCC
- 8:30am: Get our job assignments for the day and get started! Jobs will include moving classrooms to new location, finish building furniture, cleaning kitchen, and however else we are needed.
- NOON: Sack lunches will be available
- 6pm: Wrapping up with dinner at the new Sonshine Learning Center facility!

- Unloading and unpacking items at the new location
- Food and Beverage service opportunities
- Box Building

WEEK 1: JULY 28 - AUGUST 3

We will start the cleaning process of ALL of the rooms in the E-WING: 21 rooms and 4 hallways! We will remove anything and everything from these rooms to prepare for a new coat of paint, and do a quick fix up to the immediate area. The first week we will be spending time getting the space emptied and ready for the next step. This will include a deep cleaning of all bathrooms. The grout will be steamed. We will fix all toilet lids and plumbing issues and fix stalls to get ready for paint.

WEEK 2: AUGUST 4- AUGUST 10

We now can focus on paint. We do need room 402 for VBS which set up is August 12 and the rest of the week we will be serving kiddos. Room 402 will be the first room done, along with the bathrooms on FCC side and E-WING side (6 total). We will also attack the storage room 417. Items that will be addressed are cabinetry adjustments/fixing. Plumbing inspected. Electrical inspected. New lights in each room. We will be focusing on washing walls and cleaning cabinets. While we ready the rooms for the next step. Painting Hallway 1 will also begin.

WEEK 3: AUGUST 11 - AUGUST 17

Rooms 400 - 405 will be painted and freshened up. We will have the rooms cleaned and painted. Room 400 is the office space for Bobbi's team and we will be focusing on setting that up in a way that is multi functional. Room 401 is the current "break room" and we will be flipping this room into a conference room. The Elders will use this space as the team grows, and so will our deacon team. Room 403 is for our 2-3 year olds along with a quiet room (405) for nursing mothers. We will be jumping across the hallway to clean and paint room 404 and get that set up as a multi-functional teaching room. Painting Hallway 2 will begin.

WEEK 4: AUGUST 18 - AUGUST 24

Rooms 406 - 410, and our infant room 407, along with its small room for napping room 406. We will have some pack & plays available so the babies can get some shut eye. Again, we will be fixing all above items and washing windows and painting. We will have each room set up to match the appropriate age groups who are using the room. Room 408 is a bigger room and will be for a multifunctional space as well. Room 409 is currently the "barn" room and will continue to be used for 3-5 year olds. Room 410 has already been flipped by Bobbi and team so there shouldn't be much to do in there. Painting Hallway 3 will begin.

WEEK 5: AUGUST 25 - AUGUST 31

This leaves us with Rooms 411-416 to set up in a smaller way. We will be using these rooms but we will organize the "flip" in Phase 2 plans. For now we will be using the 8' tables and extra worship chairs for these classrooms. They will be clean and functional. Along with this we will need to paint and flip the D-WING. We will be relocating all items from the D Hallways back into the E-WING, and setting these rooms up for Adult learning and High School learning. These spaces will also be available for community style events. Painting hallway 4 in E-Wing will begin!

AUGUST 1-31: KITCHEN REMODEL

We will be Re-Building the kitchen!! This area is going to take some professionals and will be under the Board of Trustees watch. But some exciting things will be happening in there. New Freezer, Refrigerator, Ice Machine, Ovens, Microwaves, Sinks, Cabinets/countertops, Dishwasher, Coffee area... it's gonna be great!

SEPTEMBER 8TH: GRAND OPENING!

Our new service times will begin, classes will start, and it's time to enjoy all God has given us!

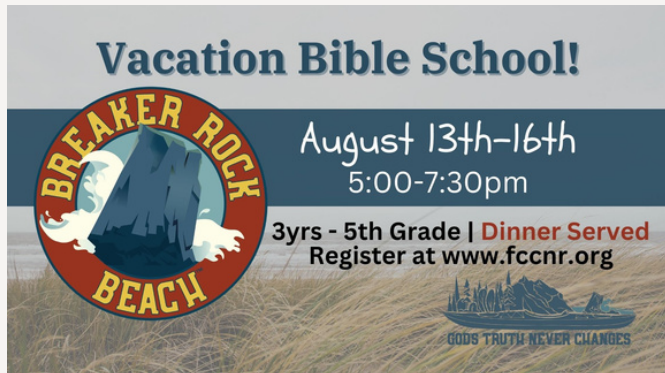

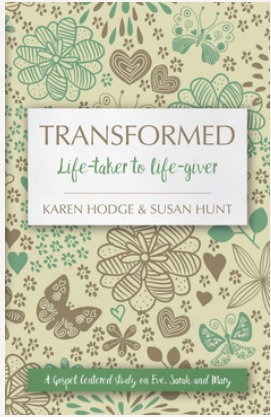

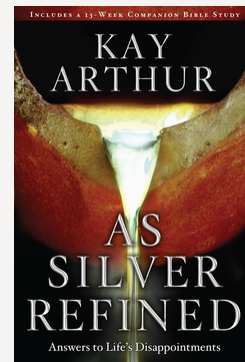
Summer Park Dates

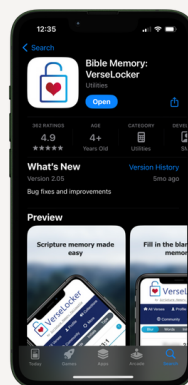

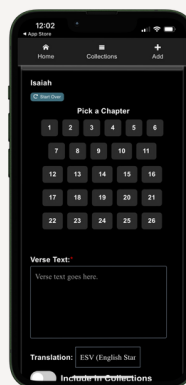

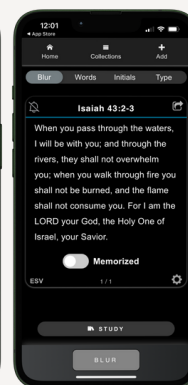

UGANDA

On Fire for the Lord

As our former pastor, Mike Evans, shared during service on Sunday, June 16, Uganda is on fire for the Lord. Mike, along with the other St. Croix Valley team, traveled to Uganda in May to share the next lesson of TLI Gospel training with their current cohort of African men. Along with this team, traveled the individual prayer cards that had been thoughtfully crafted by our church family here at Faith Community. The cohort of men were deeply moved when they received their handwritten words of prayer and encouragement, and this allowed them to realize that they have brothers and sisters in Christ on the other side of the world.

Part of the TLI training is challenging the men to take back what they've learned and teach it to others...disciple making multiplication! TLI cohort trainee, Chandiga John, along with a handful of others, had the desire and vision to bring the TLI training to those living in the refugee settlements in the Adjumani district. From the vision that was placed on their hearts, the "Ofu Loso" (Gospel is Good) ministry was born. To carry out this vision, Ofu Loso needed Bibles which Faith Community Church has supplied through mission funds.

In July, Ofu Loso will host its first session with 16 men in the Elema refugee settlement, with the other three refugee settlements to follow: 10 men in Boroli, 10 men in Maaji, and 20 men in Pagrinya. Ofu Loso also received handwritten prayer/encouragement cards from our Faith Community church family which will be distributed at the first session in each settlement. Please be in prayer for all these men as this ministry begins its first session and these men receive their Bibles, study materials, and handwritten personal prayer cards.

Chandiga John will share pictures with us of their first session...watch for those to come soon. You can pray for these men by name - lists of names of the men training in the four refugee settlements as well as the two TLI cohorts are available at the Information Desk.

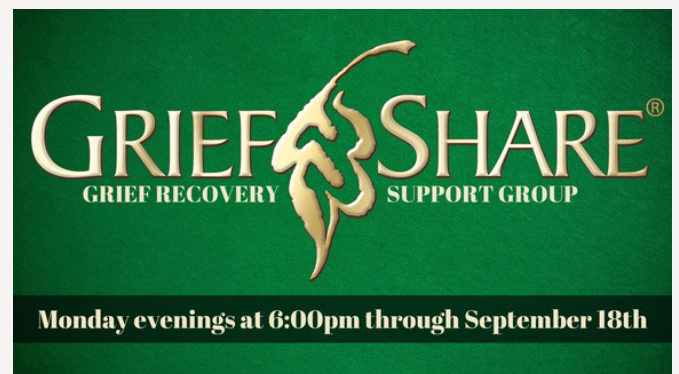


GRIEF SHARE
