OPENING PRAYER

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Read the scripture for today

1. Pastor Patrick said there are some things in the book of Acts that are descriptive and some that prescriptive. What's the difference and can you give an example of either?
2. According to the text, how are we to respond to the gospel? What does it mean to repent?
3. Why do you think baptism is coupled with repentance?
4. Is there such a thing as lone ranger Christianity in the Bible?
5. Where would you point someone in Scripture who said they are a Christian but they don't need the church?
6. Of the things that the early church devoted themselves to in Acts 2:42, which is the easiest for you to participate in? Which is the hardest?
7. What is one way you can prioritize them in your life? (Prayer and worship night on September 27)
8. What is the danger of a local church getting distracted from these priorities?
9. How is God calling you to respond to this passage?

APPLICATION

1. What is your nagging unanswered question?
2. What did you want to hear that you didn't hear from the message?
3. How can we get to know God as He is and not in the limited way we do now?
4. Think about what most caught your attention in the text or discussion. Why is God catching your attention with this at this point in your life? What does God want you to know or do?
5. What's one thing from this text that you could say to a believer/unbeliever about who God is?

PRAYER

Ask people for specific prayer requests. Pray for needs and for applications of the text. Ask for volunteers who would like to pray for those people and requests.

SHEPHERDING

Check the roster and see who is not there. Does the group know why someone is not there? Are there needs that can be met by the group? Specific prayer requests? Ask for someone to reach out and say, "We missed you."
