SUMMER SERVICES

"We are not just trying to build something big; we are trying to build something good." Those words are from a friend of mine, Brian Davis, a church planter in Minneapolis. Brian was describing his desire for Exalting Christ Church. He planted just two years ago, and attendance has already grown to around a hundred people. (If you don't know, that's incredible growth in the world of church planting.) But, Brian's desire is not merely for numerical growth - but spiritual depth. He longs for God to build a congregation of disciples who are grounded in the Bible and love God and love one another.

Those words have stayed with me. That's my prayer for Faith Community Church. Like Brian's church, God has blessed FCC with numerical increase, and we give thanks. But if we just become a show that people attend on Sunday mornings - like going to a movie - I think we have missed Jesus' vision for the church. In John 13:35 Jesus said, "By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." Church should be a place where we genuinely love other disciples of Jesus. If we miss this, we lose the one of the central hallmarks of biblical Christianity.

In a desire to help us grow in loving one another, the Pastors and Elders have decided to combine both Sunday services for the Summer. Starting May 31st, we will gather for a joint worship service at 10am, with Sunday School at 9am. We will resume two services in after our Summer Picnic in August.

Our goal in bringing the whole church together is to foster greater unity, fellowship and friendship. But this will only happen if we all embrace that goal and participate in it. So here is my challenge: "Don't just attend—engage! Look for someone you don't know and talk to them. Pray with them and for others. Invite another family out to lunch. Step outside your comfort zone, and let's see how God might build something not just big, but truly good.

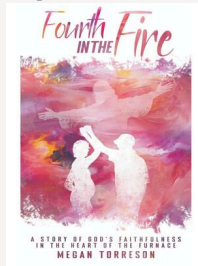

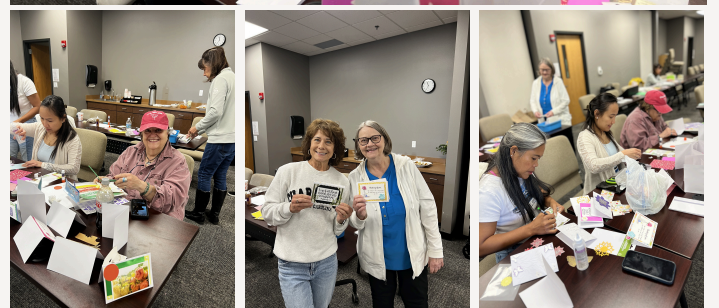
Stay tuned for our next Secret Sister event which kicks off in January each year. Ladies (ages 12 and up), we look forward to having you join us!

GLOBAL MISSIONS

...we make disciples that plant the church...here, near, and far...

Adjumani Refugee Settlements - Uganda:

For more than a year, the OFO LOSO ministry - Chandiga John, Edema Godfrey, Ameku Godfrey, Eruaga Godwin Patrick, Taban Francis Lodi, Izama Emmanuel, Makpwe Richard Anzo, Mindra Emmanuel Patrick, and Taban Francis Delfin - former graduates of Abaana's Hope Pastoral Training Center, have faithfully been bringing the TLI training into the refugee settlements of Elema, Boroli, Maaji, and Pagrinya located in the Adjumani district.

The Ugandan government has changed how people living within the settlements receive support. The plot of land where they live has decreased in size and is no longer large enough for a shelter as well as a small food plot. The amount of government subsidized food available to families has also decreased. Because of this, these TLI training pastors have found it difficult to leave their families and find host families during the week for each training session.

With assistance from Faith Community Church, beginning May 4, 2026, these men will spend a week training 40+ pastors/spiritual leaders within the refugee settlements. Through mission funds, the TLI training materials were provided as well as assistance for support to provide food and shelter during the week while these men are away from their families and living with a host family.

In addition to giving assistance so these men could be cared for during the weeklong training, FCC mission funds were also sent so 5 acres of land could be "opened" (plowed) so the OFO LOSO ministry could plant maize and beans. Planting these crops will allow them to feed their families, have food during the weekly trainings, and sell some of the excess to provide for future ministry expenses.

Kitgum, Uganda:

Located in northern Uganda, a short distance from the southern border of South Sudan, lies the community of Kitgum, Uganda. Pastor Edwin Onen planted Kitgum Community Church and serves as the Lead Pastor. God has placed a huge burden on Pastor Edwin's heart for the families and children of the communities of northern Uganda - communities with refugees from nearby war-torn countries. Pastor travels to the identified possible church plant communities of Mucwini, Latanya, and Larobi, and practices door to door evangelism.

Through relationship building conversations with Pastor Edwin, it was learned how transportation is a real hurdle and a motorcycle would be an incredible blessing for his ministry. While sharing about FCC's global mission involvement, a member of FCC learned of Pastor Edwin's motorcycle need, and God placed it on his heart to provide. Edwin and his wife, Evelyn, were absolutely overjoyed at how their prayers were answered.



A letter from Pastor Edwin:

We believe this is a direct answer to prayer and we recognize that God has provided this tool for His work. This motorcycle is a "chariot for the mission field". It will allow us to travel further and more efficiently to villages, schools, and homes to share the message of Christ and enables our team to overcome transportation barriers, ensuring consistency in our outreach program.

Thank you for being part of the story God is writing in our community.

Taban Francis Delfin continues to bring the TLI training to Pastors and church leaders in South Sudan. Ameku Godfrey has traveled from Uganda to South Sudan to help Taban when needed and God is creating miraculous changes in how pastors are learning and experience His word. The training will allow them to share the truth and spread His Gospel in their churches and communities.



Our African Ministry Partners to attend Conference:

In May, Chandiga John of OFO LOSO, Pastor Edwin of Kitgum Community Church, and Ameku Godfrey and Taban Francis Delfin (OFO LOSO & South Sudan training), will all travel to Abaana's Hope in Gulu, Uganda. The Living Stones Pastoral Training Center at Abaana's has invited 100 former graduates of the PTC to participate in The Living Stones Abiding Network of African Led Churches Pastor's Conference led by Pastor Mwindula Mbewe of Hillview Baptist Church in Osaka, Zambia. He will teach African issues and Apologetics, and the attendees will receive Farming God's Way training to create self-sustainable income for their families and churches.

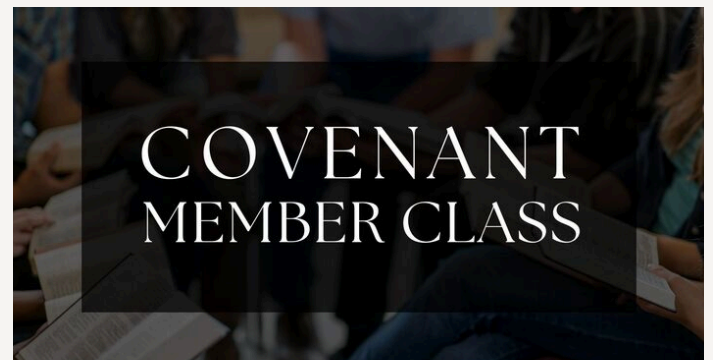

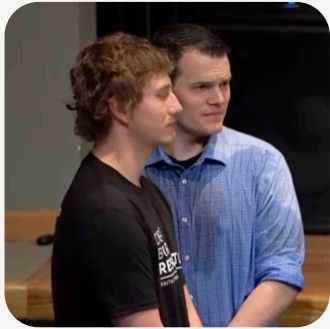

Movie Review

THE GREAT AWAKENING

Now Available to Stream

I was recently encouraged to see the movie, *A Great Awakening*, about one man, used by God to powerfully shape a nation. I didn't have high expectations for this film. I find a lot of "faith-based movies" to be painful - often ruined by poor writing, mediocre acting and sometimes even sprinkled with a false gospel. *A Great Awakening* was quite different and I am delighted to urge others to see it as well.

A Great Awakening is the historical account of revival, sparked by George Whitefield's rebirth, that swept through the colonies before the signing of the Declaration of Independence. It is told through the eyes of Benjamin Franklin and follows his close friendship with the itinerant evangelist. I believe this is part of the movie's impact. Despite Franklin's unbelief, he cherished and esteemed Whitefield deeply and was drawn in by his friend's capacity and booming voice that attracted thousands in order to hear the gospel.

The movie is raw and authentic as it follows Whitefield's life. It doesn't white wash his flaws or weaknesses. I appreciate this, as our tendency might be to worship mere men instead of the Savior. The acting - especially of George Whitefield (Jonathan Blair) is exceptional, with the script often being taken straight from his real-life sermons.

One of the more moving scenes is Whitefield's conversion. After nearly dying while attempting salvation through works such as fasting and exposure, Whitefield encounters Christ's transforming grace and becomes a force.

His life turns to one of surrender, passion and courage - traveling thousands of miles on horseback to preach an estimated 30,000 sermons across the colonies and in England. A man desperate to share the truth, love and grace of Christ with a world in need.

I cried through most of the movie. It left me with conviction, a sadness for the state of our country and a hope for what could be if Christians had just a fraction of the urgency George Whitefield had for the lost and for an awakening in this land. See this movie and let it move you to much prayer, much time in the Word and much sharing of the gospel.

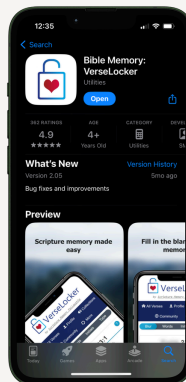


MEMORY CARDS

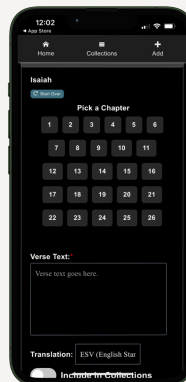

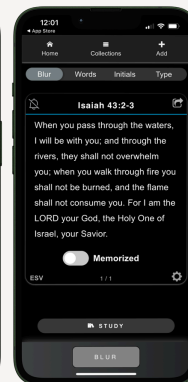
