Q & A

Patrick Nickerson

Here are a few questions we asked Pat to help us get to know a little more about him! You can also watch his introductory video [HERE!](#)

Q: How old are you?

A: 33

Q: Where did you grow up?

A: Chesapeake, VA

Q: Do you have any siblings?

A: I'm an only child :-)

Q: Can you tell us about your family (wife, children, pets)?

A: The fact that my wife Rachel married me is proof positive that miracles still do occur. We've been married since 2018 and next to salvation through Christ, Rachel is the best thing that's ever happened to me.

I have 4 children: Eden (6), Ana (4), Kohen (2), and Emmett (9 months). Eden is very creative and silly. Ana loves dresses and all things girly. Kohen is obsessed with spiderman, and Emmett is an extremely chunky, smiley baby who's getting more and more mobile.

Q: Can you tell us about your education?

A: I went to public school growing up and did not at all like learning. When the Lord saved me I started to love learning, especially theology. I graduated from Regent University with a Bachelor's in Business in 2014. In 2016 I was still single and had a decent amount of time on my hands. I thought that one day far in the future I might like to go into vocational ministry, so I decided to go to seminary. I graduated from Virginia Beach Theological Seminary in 2018 with a Masters in Biblical Studies. I was offered a scholarship - a free semester of Hebrew - so I stuck around and did that as well.



I'm currently taking classes online at the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary in the MDiv program. I have 6 or 7 classes left in the program. It's been an incredible joy, but a lot of work!

Q: What made you want to do Ministry?

A: Partly my desire for ministry comes from the fact that I can't get enough of being in God's word. Having a word-centered vocation is one of the most joyful things in the world to me. Beyond my own personal enjoyment, I love seeing people transformed as they behold the glory of Christ in the gospel.

Q: What is your favorite Bible verse?

A: I can't pick just one! But one of my favorites would have to be Hebrews 10:14: "For by a single offering he has perfected for all time those who are being sanctified." In this single sentence we see the efficacy, eternity, and extent of Christ's sacrifice. The cross is entirely efficacious: it "perfects." The cross perfects "for all time": eternally. And the extent of this perfection is "those who are being sanctified": those who have been set apart for Christ and are being conformed to his image.

Q: Do you have any favorite snacks or drinks?

A: There are these chips called “Wilde” chips. They’re made out of chicken breast, egg whites, and bone broth. Now hear me out! You would think that they would be gross. But the buffalo ones taste exactly like buffalo wings (which I love). So I love Wilde chips!

Q: Do you have any hidden talents?

A: I’m decent at skateboarding actually. It was normal on the coast where I grew up for just about everyone to skateboard!

Q: Are there any books or podcasts that have significantly influenced you lately?

A: I recently re-listened to C.S. Lewis’ *That Hideous Strength*. The book is something of a narrative exposition of his other works *The Abolition of Man* and also *The Inner Ring*. In *The Inner Ring*, Lewis talks about the dangerous desire to be “in” with certain social circles; how it can lead you to do things you don’t even really enjoy, and even neglect people you really love in order to saddle up beside “important people” who you think will bring you closer to the center of whatever circle you’re wanting to be in. *That Hideous Strength* plays out these themes in narrative form, and I always find it extremely insightful, convicting, and encouraging.

Q: What do you like to do for fun in your free time with your family?

A: We like to go on walks together or play at the park. In the summer the kids like to look for frogs, bugs, and worms under rocks (especially the girls!). We like to go swimming, camping, and sledding in the winter. I’m hoping to get us into snowboarding/skiing.

Q: Do you have any favorite hobbies?

A: In Virginia my favorite hobby was surfing. These days the only surfing I’m doing if any is the internet! I like to read, play the guitar, and exercise.

Q: What are you most looking forward to in your new role at FCC?

A: I can’t wait to get into the word together and to start building relationships as we get to know everyone.

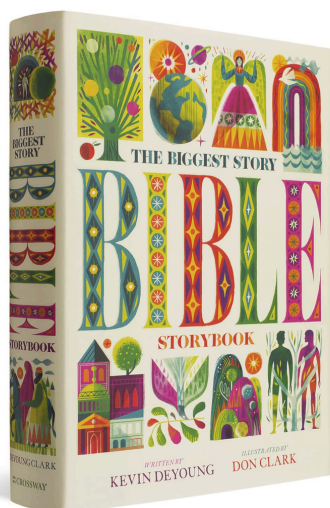
BOOK RECOMMENDATION

The Biggest Story Bible Storybook

"The Bible is a BIG book about the BIGGEST story. Each page tells about the God who created the world, acted in history, and continues to act in the present. In The Biggest Story Bible Storybook, Pastor Kevin DeYoung shares this grand story with children ages 6-12 through 104 short chapters.

Beginning in Genesis and ending with Revelation, DeYoung provides engaging retellings of various Bible stories, explaining how they fit into the overarching storyline. Each reading is coupled with beautiful illustrations by award-winning artist Don Clark and concludes with a reflective prayer. Perfect for bedtime stories or to read together as a family, both children and parents alike will experience afresh the captivating story of the Bible in an easy-to-understand, compelling way."

Though this book is recommended for ages 6-12, it is never too early to read these stories to your kids or grandkids! During the summer, KidZone uses The Biggest Story curriculum for all of our kids in grades 4K-5th grade. Meet Tammy Olsen

How long have you been serving in Children's Ministry?

I came to know Jesus as my Lord and Savior when I was fifteen years old. Children's ministry became part of my story shortly after. In the past 30 years I've helped in many capacities: VBS, a Bible Camp Counselor, a youth group leader, mission trips both overseas and locally with teens, and teaching in Sunday School. I've been so blessed in my walk with Jesus to have others come alongside me and point me more toward Him. Serving in Children's Ministry has been an opportunity for me to try and help point others toward knowing Him better!

Which position do you currently serve in?

I am currently co-teaching the 4th and 5th grade Sunday School class with Janna. It requires time, but I love it! We've got great kids in our class, curriculum that is challenging but written well enough that it's a joy to teach, and support and encouragement from those in leadership. It stretches me and causes me to go deeper.

Why do you think Children's Ministry is important?

The kids in our classes are the next generation of believers! I want them to know their Bible. I don't want them to be tossed to and fro when someone says something is written in the Bible. I want them to know their GOD and His Word well enough that they can confidently ask where something is found in the Bible and read it in context taking into account the whole authority of scripture.

What would you tell people who might be considering serving with our children/youth?

I love in Acts 4:13 how it says, "now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated, common men, they were astonished. And they recognized that they had been with Jesus." This verse comforts me in that I don't need to have all the answers. It's my prayer that God shows them Jesus in spite of me and that's what they remember. For those who are considering serving with our children/youth, I'd ask you a few questions that someone once asked me. If not you, then who? If not here, then where? If not now, then when? If God is guiding you into any ministry, please step out in faith. Jump in and watch God show up! I can honestly say watching Him show up and work and move is my favorite part!

Funniest/most memorable child quote you've heard while serving:

I work with 4th and 5th graders who would kill me if I answered this question! ;) Just kidding! Honestly, my favorite moments are when they ask questions about faith or understand something for the first time.

WE MAKE DISCIPLES

Who Plant the Church...in South Sudan!

We are seeing the fruit of multiplying disciples from FCC's many years partnering with TLI and the training Mike Evans, Stu Dix, and Larry Szyman have poured into pastors in Uganda. A few months ago, our Missions team was presented with an opportunity to partner with a young man named Taban, who has a vision to train over 300 leaders in South Sudan who need sound biblical training to lead and shepherd the people. We are excited to share how God is already moving through the faithfulness of this young man!

In March, 48 pastors with a hunger to "know God and make Him known" gathered in Liu, South Sudan, for a 7-day intensive training on TLI's Knowing God, Scriptures, and Ourselves as well as the Gospel and Conversion from 9 Marks. This is the first ever training of this kind to be offered to these men, and it was led by Taban and 2 other graduates from the TLI training! The first group of South Sudanese pastors to experience the training began connecting with each other, and a spirit of camaraderie and fellowship is already developing.

One of the trainees, Silvestor, said: "I thank God for the opportunities of training. I learn the new things about the sovereignty of God which teach him that he exist up to now is the sovereignty of God. I learn how to preach according to scripture. I want to thank this young men for teaching them though majorities of us were old/elders but these teachers tried to teach them from the Bible." (all grammar is his)



We are excited about the vision of this team and the potential for them to help grow and multiply the church in South Sudan! Our ongoing FCC partnership will assist the team with travel expenses and provide printed materials for the training as they continue to teach South Sudanese pastors over the next 3 years.

Please join us in praying:

- Pray for the next training, which begins April 12th
- Pray for the pastors who are traveling long distances to receive this training
- Ask God to help the pastors understand and be faithful to begin implementing the training they receive; much of this is very new to them and may be difficult to apply in their contexts
- Ask God to give understanding to those who are receiving the training in a secondary language to their heart language; may the Holy Spirit be their teacher
- Pray that God will create sustainability in this through ongoing support and follow-up with the pastors after the training; pray the pastors will be able to networks together
- Pray that God will grow His church through this partnership that FCC is privileged to be part of
- Ask God to make us faithful to pray for this work!! Finances are only part of our partnership!

Book Recommendation

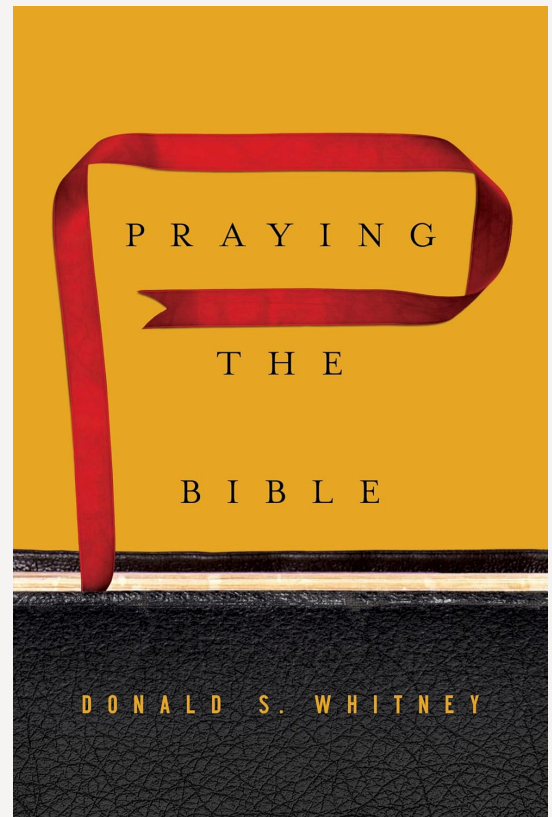
PRAYING THE BIBLE

by Donald S. Whitney

My father-in-law recommended the book, "Praying The Bible" by Donald S. Whitney, to me over 12 years ago. It is such a short, easy-to-read book that I finished it within a day but it made a lasting impression on me that I don't think I fully realized until I recently picked it up again. "Praying the Bible" transformed the way I talked to God, so much so that I made myself a little prayer closet after reading it.

The basis of the book is that most Spirit-indwelled, Bible-believing, truly born-again Christians struggle to have a consistent, meaningful prayer time. I know this has been true for me on and off over the years. Whitney suggests that this isn't due to a lack of desire or resources, but rather the method we use. He proposes, "I maintain that people... often do not pray simply because they do not feel like it. And the reason they don't feel like praying is that when they do pray, they tend to say the same old things about the same old things."

Whitney's solution to this obstacle is very straightforward, "when you pray, pray through a passage of Scripture, particularly a psalm". Whitney spends most of his chapters teaching this method practically, including specific examples along the way. His fatherly tone walks Christians through what it looks like to pray some of the differing genres of the Bible - narrative, poetry, gospels, epistles. Whitney becomes like a mentor giving confidence to the reader that our prayer life can truly be rejuvenated - and permanently so.

The book ends by explaining how praying the Bible tends to impact the people Whitney has taught over the years. I heartily agree with every point! I now come excitedly before the throne of God. I find that it is rare for me to come to the Word without praying God's words back to Him. It has become a habit. I have verses memorized, seemingly without effort, all because I was able to think deeply enough about them through prayer. As Whitney explains, "Basically what you are doing is taking the words that originated in the heart and mind of God and circulating them through your heart and mind back to God. By this means His words become the wings of your prayers."

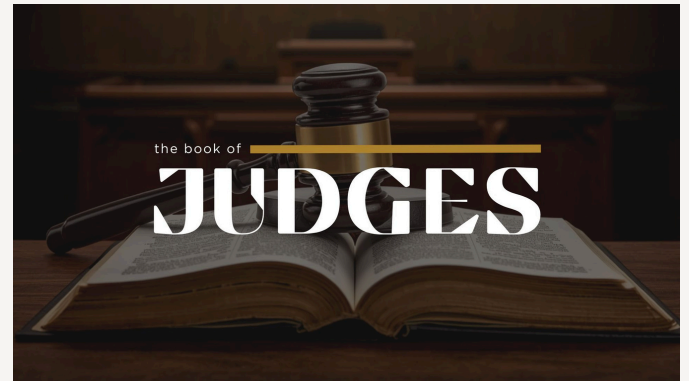
NEW SERMON SERIES
