TITLE: Walking on Water

SCRIPTURE: Matthew 14:22-36

OPENING PRAYER ICE BREAKER

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Read the scripture for today

- 1. What does this story reveal about the temperament of Peter? Of the other eleven?
- 2. Are you like them in any way?
- 3. In the Old Testament, the storm that Jonah faced was because of his disobedience. In Matthew 14, the disciples faced contrary winds even though they were obeying Jesus.
- 4. How do you account for this?
- 5. Does following Jesus mean less trouble or more trouble for us?
- 6. Read the account of Jesus calming an earlier storm in Matthew 8:23-27.
- 7. What differences do you see in the disciples' reaction to the storm? In their reaction to Jesus' actions?
- 8. When Jesus told Peter that he had little faith, do you think he was angry or smiling?
- 9. What does this story reveal about who Jesus is?
- 10. In what area of life are you rowing against the wind, and need stronger faith?
- 11. What is the purpose of the trials that enter our lives? (Read 1 Peter 1:6-7)

APPLICATION

- 1. What is your nagging unanswered question?
- 2. What did you want to hear that you didn't hear from the message?
- 3. How can we get to know God as He is and not in the limited way we do now?
- 4. Think about what most caught your attention in the text or discussion. Why is God catching your attention with this at this point in your life? What does God want you to know or do?
- 5. What's one thing from this text that you could say to a believer/unbeliever about who God is?

PRAYER

Ask people for specific prayer requests. Pray for needs and for applications of the text. Ask for volunteers who would like to pray for those people and requests.

SHEPHERDING

Check the roster and see who is not there. Does the group know why someone is not there? Are there needs that can be meet by the group? Specific prayer requests? Ask for someone to reach out and say, "We missed you."
