a letter from Pastor Patrick

DEAR FCC FAMILY:

I want to start off by telling you how happy I am to be your new pastor, and how excited my family and I are to be part of this congregation. We have truly been overwhelmed by the love of God that has been demonstrated through your care, generosity, and hospitality. We were supported at every point, from our move here to becoming acclimated to our new home. We are truly thankful for all of you!

I have been asked on several occasions what I plan to do. As I begin my tenure here at Faith Community Church, I have attempted to spend time listening, and I want to learn from the saints that have been serving and ministering here for years. FCC has a godly heritage of making disciples who plant the church, and I want to honor that history as we seek to be faithful in the present, and as we look forward to fruitfulness in the future.

I also recognize that our church has been through a turbulent period of leadership turnover. I have listened while several of you have shared with me just how painful that was. Some of you have even shared your hesitancy about fully reengaging. I cannot change the past, but I would love the opportunity to earn your trust and rebuild credibility. On behalf of the Pastors and Elders, the goal of the leadership of Faith Community Church is to exemplify transparency and Christian integrity in all we do. Our goal is reconciliation and the restoration of unity around the truth of the gospel, but that can only happen through love, humility, and patience.

As we move forward, let me share my simple plan: preach, pray, love and stay. I begin with preaching because it is the word of God that drives the church. In 2 Timothy 4:2, Paul commands Timothy, "preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, and exhort, with complete patience and teaching." The word of God is our final authority, not the opinion or preference of any man. In my meetings with members of the staff, I have told



them "We are not going to lead this church through personality, because I don't have enough personality to do that. We are going to be a people of the book."

Second, prayer is a fundamental part of a New Testament Church. 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 says, "Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you." To that end, I have encouraged all of the Elders, the Deacons and the staff to regularly be praying through our membership rolls. We will also be starting a prayer chain that members can sign up for. I truly believe that any fruitfulness that FCC will have in the future starts with, and will be sustained, only through prayer.

Finally, if our lives are not marked by love our ministry is meaningless. Paul writes in 1 Corinthians 13:2, "if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing." Love is the necessary fruit of real Christian faith. My desire is to lead our church in loving God, loving one another, and loving the lost.

I remember hearing a wise old preacher saying, "We overestimate what we can do in a year and underestimate what God can do in five." No growth happens overnight. Change takes time, and as a sinful man, I won't always do things in the right way, so I am asking for your patience. But my plan is to be here for many years, and my prayer is that over time the Lord would grant His favor to our church.

OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

9,745 boxes sent

This is what 9,745 shoebox gifts look like! With the miracle of multiplication, about 97,745 people will hear The Gospel through these "GO" (Gospel Opportunity) shoebox gifts.

New Richmond FCC:

Contributed a total of 424 shoebox gifts; had 35 volunteers serve over National Collection week just in NR, for a total of 211 volunteer hours; our NR drop off welcomed 42 people from our community/local churches who brought another 561 shoeboxes for a total of 985 shoeboxes collected at FCC New Richmond.

Western Wisconsin has 6 drop off locations; had 128 volunteers serve 547 volunteer hours; loaded 645 cartons containing 9,745 shoebox gifts into two semi trailers!

We had two different people stop in that were looking for a new church home. One person heard of our location on KTIS, and didn't realize there was a drop off in NR. She currently attends Eagle Brook but is wanting something closer to home and will be checking us out in the future.

Paul had a great conversation with the other person. A guy looking for a new church, I heard "Come on back! Let's worship together!"

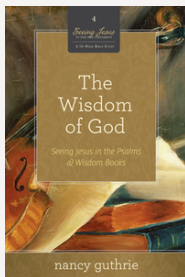

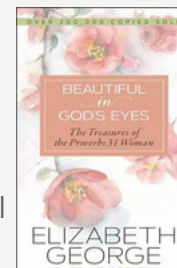

Faith Training - Updates and Plans

WHAT IS FAITH TRAINING AT FCC?

Faith Training is all about making Disciples. We provide teachers and learning opportunities for those who hunger to know more. In order to give everyone an opportunity to attend, we offer some classes as one-time meetings, and others as weekly classes which meet on different days and times of the week.

Some of our classes explore specific books of the Bible, and others take us into Scripture to understand our own spiritual experience (theological formation). Pastor Patrick said we all have a theology: who we think God is and what Christ has done for us.

Other classes are more about living the Gospel out in parenting, work, and our world, while others will explore the history of the Church and what we can learn from the past. But, all of it is about growing in the Gospel and making disciples.

2024 Faith Training Opportunities are coming together. Though some details are not finalized yet, I wanted to let you know what we do know:

UNPACKING THE GOSPEL TREASURES will begin Sunday morning January 14. The class will be held from 10:30am-12:00pm in the Family Room across from the café. We will be studying justification, redemption, reconciliation, sanctification, and several more biblical concepts that comprise the many treasures of our salvation in Christ. Pastor Dave will be heading up this class which will run for 6 weeks. We have a limit of 20 people so don't wait until the last minute to sign up!

“THE OLOGY: ANCIENT TRUTHS, EVER NEW”

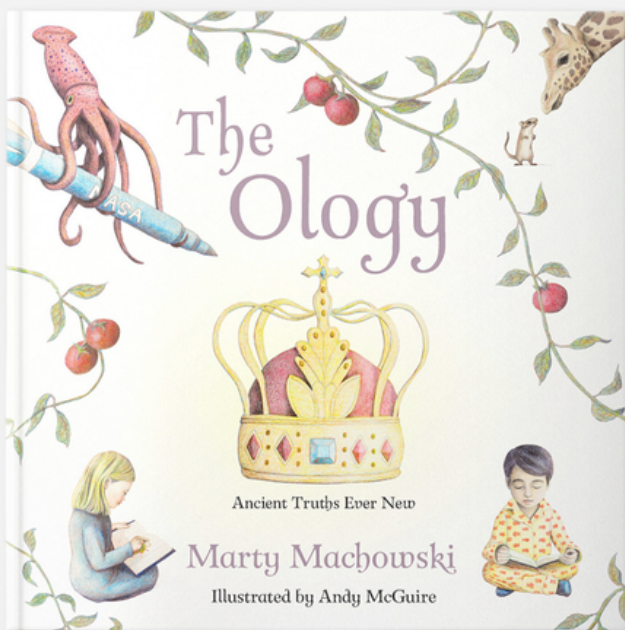
