



Faith Community sent a team to serve alongside Pastor Antonio of Vida Real Church and School in San Pablo la Laguna, Guatemala. The team introduced Pickle Ball to the children at Vida Real School, which was exciting and entertaining for both the mission team and the school children. Ed & Pam Domenzain are avid pickle ball players and were able to round up equipment to bring for the school to use for Physical Education classes.













Visiting Vida Real's church plants was one of the things the team hoped to do while there, but God had other plans. During the team's time in Guatemala, Pastor Antonio's mother-in-law, Ana, passed away which allowed the team to support Pastor Antonio and his family in a totally different way.

The team was able to spend time with Pedro, Ana's husband. Pedro was involved with Wycliffe and the original translation of the Old Testament Bible into a native Guatemalan language, Tz'utujil. There is a desire amongst the Guatemalan people to have a Bible in this language, and this may be an opportunity of involvement for FCC in the future.





ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL

Session 1





Our "Christianity Explored" and "Understanding God's Design for a Healthy Church" classes are underway with over 50 participants each week. We are grateful for more opportunities to learn and grow alongside you! You are welcome to jump in anytime! Session 2 will kickoff on November 9th! We will be splitting up the men and the women for this 6 week class to focus on what the Bible says about Biblical Manhood and Womanhood!

Session 2: "What Makes A Man?"

What makes a man? The apostle Paul exhorts us in 1 Corinthians 16:13-...act like men...! What does that mean.? We must "be" before we can "act."

Our present culture refers to masculinity as Toxic. Many are calling fatherlessness an epidemic. Many young men are reacting to the confusion over manliness by listening to worldly understandings which are far from what God designed and desires for us.

Beginning November 9 we will start a series entitled, "What Makes A Man?" Our goal is to provide a safe environment where we help people grow as disciples of Jesus Christ. 
