LEAVING A LEGACY

When I was very little, my favorite day of the week was Monday. Every Monday, my grandfather would pick my brother and I up so we could spend the day with him, and I loved going to my grandparents' house. My grandfather would always show up in his old van, and we would come running out of the house and clamber into his vehicle. He had a tradition that every time we entered the van and put on our seatbelts, we would all sing a song together:

*The B-I-B-L-E
Yes, that's the book for me
I stand alone on the Word of God
The B-I-B-L-E. Bible!!!*

I was four years old when my grandpa died, but that message stuck with me from a very early age. As I grew older, even when I walked away from Christianity, there was always a part of me that knew the Bible was true. I would run from it. I would try to ignore it. But the one thing I couldn't do, was deny it. I came to saving faith in Jesus towards the end of High School, and yet again, it was through the teaching of the Bible. Even after becoming a Christian, I experienced challenges to my faith. But, those challenges never shook my faith, and one of the reasons was because my grandfather had laid that foundation long ago. It was a foundation that God would later build upon.



At Faith Community Church, we want to help you lay a solid biblical foundation for your life and for your children and grandchildren. One of the ways we are doing that is through Scripture memorization. The Bible says, "I have stored up your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you" (Psalm 119:11). Our goal is to equip you with strategic verses to strengthen you and help you grow in your faith. Every month we will memorize a different verse. The verse will be shared during announcements in the service, can be found in the bulletin, and will be on the home page of our website. There will also be little memory cards* available at the doors so you can take them home with you.

I am asking for your participation and support in helping others make this a regular practice in their lives. I want to encourage all the parents and grandparents reading this to use these verses to plant gospel seeds in the lives of your children and grandchildren. You have a significant part to play in passing on your faith to the next generation.

My grandfather didn't live to see the impact he had had on me, but the legacy of the veracity and authority of Scripture have shaped my life. I pray that each of us would leave such a legacy.

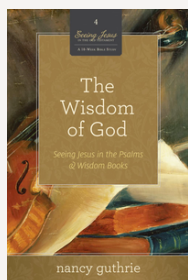

GRAFT DAY

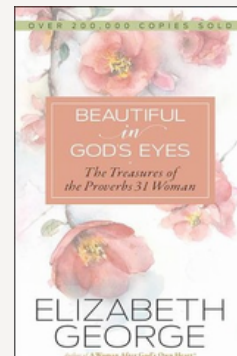
Last Saturday, a group of ladies met here at FCC to work on their craft projects while enjoying the fellowship of other women!

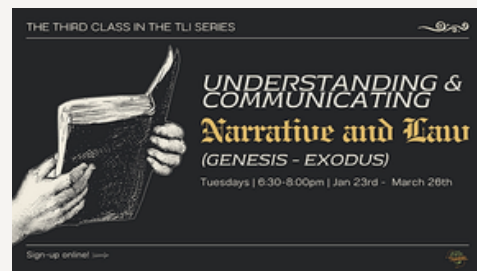

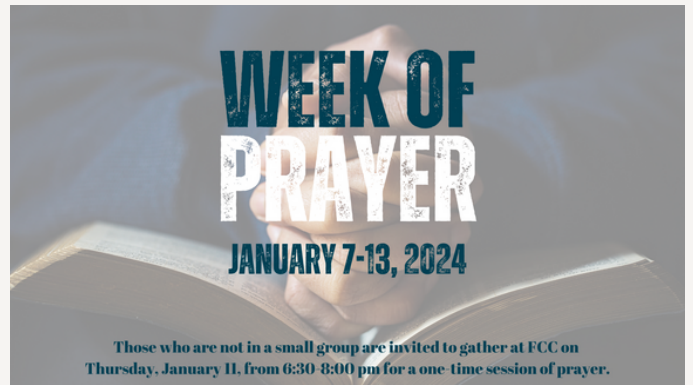
PRAYER TEAM

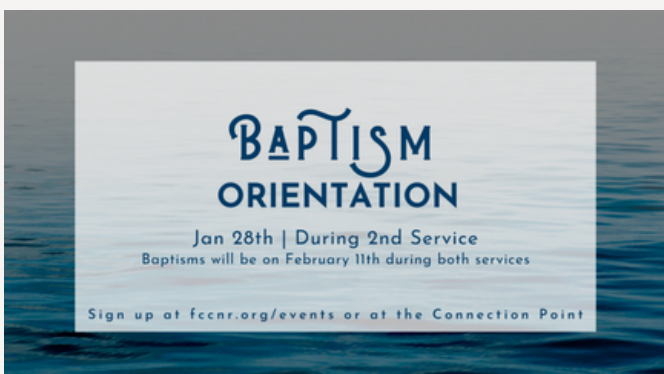


BAPTISM ORIENTATION

Orientation class will be held on Sunday, January 28th during second service, and Baptisms will be on Sunday, February 11th. Please register [online](#) so we can connect with you!



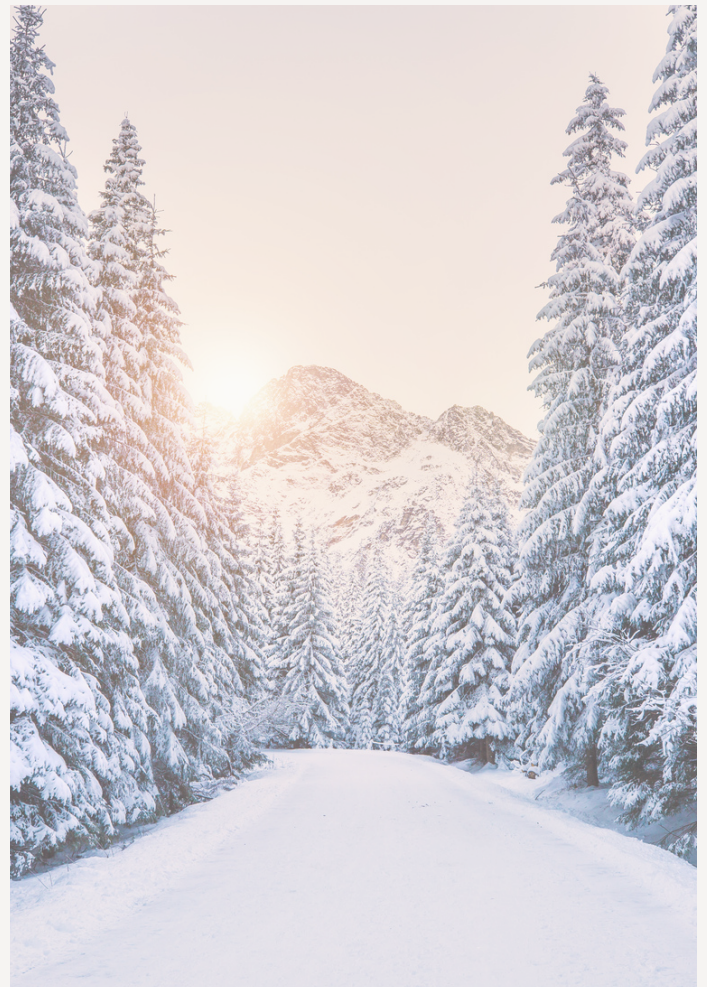
SMALL GROUPS

Prayer for Abounding Generosity

Exodus 36:3-7:

And they received from Moses all the contribution that the people of Israel had brought for doing the work on the sanctuary. They still kept bringing him freewill offerings every morning, so that all the craftsmen who were doing every sort of task on the sanctuary came, each from the task that he was doing, and said to Moses, "The people bring much more than enough for doing the work that the Lord has commanded us to do." So Moses gave command, and word was proclaimed throughout the camp, "Let no man or woman do anything more for the contribution for the sanctuary." So the people were restrained from bringing, for the material they had was sufficient to do all the work, and more.

The people in this passage responded so generously in bringing materials for the work that was being done, that Moses asked them to stop giving! Let this be an encouragement to us to be a people who are exceedingly generous as well as we do things for Christ.
