# Read the scripture for today

- 1. Look at Jesus feeding the five thousand in Matthew 14, and feeding the four thousand in Matthew 15. What are the similarities? What are the differences?
- 2. How would you define Christ's compassion?
- 3. Why was it so scandalous that Jesus cared about the gentiles?
- 4. Read Galatians 3:8. What was God's plan in blessing Abraham?
- 5. Who does Jesus have compassion on in this passage? What does this tell us about Jesus?
- 6. Why do you think Jesus' disciples responded so negatively when he said he wanted to feed the crowd?
- 7. Who do you have difficulty showing compassion towards?
- 8. Where is one place where you can give Jesus your "seven loaves and few small fish" to use as he sees fit?
- 9. What has God given you that you can share with others?
- 10. Who can you bring to Jesus?

## **APPLICATION**

- 1. What is your nagging unanswered question?
- 2. What did you want to hear that you didn't hear from the message?
- 3. How can we get to know God as He is and not in the limited way we do now?
- 4. Think about what most caught your attention in the text or discussion. Why is God catching your attention with this at this point in your life? What does God want you to know or do?
- 5. What's one thing from this text that you could say to a believer/unbeliever about who God is?

#### PRAYER

Ask people for specific prayer requests. Pray for needs and for applications of the text. Ask for volunteers who would like to pray for those people and requests.

#### SHEPHERDING

Check the roster and see who is not there. Does the group know why someone is not there? Are there needs that can be meet by the group? Specific prayer requests? Ask for someone to reach out and say, "We missed you."
