## NEW SERMON SERIES

Dear Faith Family,  
This week marks the beginning of our summer sermon series. We are walking through the Apostle Paul's first letter to his young protégé, Timothy. Timothy is the new pastor of the church of Ephesus. While the letter was written to Timothy, Paul seems to have intended for the letter to be read by the rest of the church as well. It is chocked full of biblical wisdom for how Christians are to live with one another in the context of a local church.

The series is entitled "The Church: A Pillar of the Truth," and comes directly from a verse in the middle of the letter.

**1 Timothy 3:15,**  
***"if I delay, you may know how one ought to behave in the household of God, which is the church of the living God, a pillar and buttress of the truth."***


In this verse, Paul is exhorting Timothy to persevere as the pastor in Ephesus until he returns, and tells him that he is writing the letter so that they would know "you may know how one ought to behave in the household of God..." There is a manner in which we ought to behave as Christians within the church. There is a correct order to the church. That also implies the fact there is a wrong way to behave and incorrect order to the church. But that raises the question: Who gets to determine what is right and what is wrong? And the obvious answer that Paul gives is... God.

Notice Paul calls it the "household of God." It's his church, and God gives us directions for *His church in His word!* I know that may seem obvious, but consider how many times Christians get into fights in churches over things that have nothing to do with God's word or God's church, and everything to do with their own personal desires and opinions.

Finally, notice that Paul refers to the church as the pillar and buttress of the truth. A pillar is a column that is meant to hold something else up. A pillar is not meant to be the point in and of itself. The pillar is meant to point to, promote, and support whatever rests upon it, and in 1 Timothy 3:15, Paul says that the church exists to promote and support the truth of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. The church is founded on the gospel. That's what makes a church to be a church.

If you have questions about church or why we do things the way we do them at Faith Community Church, I would like to invite you join us over the Summer as we delve into the book of 1 Timothy.

## LADIES TIME OUT


### Wednesday, May 21st at 9am

- Will remain unchanged


### Children's Church-

- Will include about 45 minutes of outside/game time (Please dress children accordingly and provide a sweater/light jacket for chilly days.)

### Sunday School-

- Will contain two classes
  - (4K-1st) will meet in E1
  - (2nd-4th) will meet in E2
  - 5th graders will move up to the Middle School Sunday School class
  - Will occasionally do some activities outside (Please dress children accordingly and provide a sweater/light jacket for chilly days.)

\*\*Please note: We do not promote children's grades until the fall. They should continue in their current grade through the summer.

## COVENANT MEETING CHILDCARE

Childcare during FCC events always presents a bit of a challenge as attendance, age ranges, and volunteers vary greatly. Making sure we have adequate volunteers and a safe volunteer-to-child ratio is very difficult when we don't know ahead of time what the need will be. One such event that we would like to better prepare for is our Covenant Member Meetings. Going forward, we're going to make the following changes:

1. We will post an event on the Events page with a place to RSVP for childcare about a month ahead of the next meeting, asking the number and ages of children planning to attend. Please complete this as soon as possible so we can look for volunteers.
2. With the Event, there will also be a place to sign up to volunteer to help. You do not need to be a member, but you will need a current background check and to review the KidZone Handbook prior to serving.
3. Children ages 10 and under will either need to be with a parent in the meeting, or be checked into KidZone by a parent.
4. Children ages 11+ will have the option of being outside, or at the meeting itself (we will provide a table with some crafts/coloring pages).

Thank you so much for helping us to not only provide childcare for the parents that need it, but to make sure our childcare is adequate for the number of children attending!


We're excited to share a few events planned for this summer through the Men's Ministry! We have a great lineup, including bags tournaments, golf outings, and a Twins game.

## GRIEF SHARE

### Wrapping Up Our 4<sup>th</sup> Session

Grief is like a journey, and it can often feel like walking alone in the dark without a flashlight. Sometimes we wonder if we are moving forward or simply wandering in circles. We desire relief from the pain, the sadness, the unanswered questions, and other complicated emotions. GriefShare is a Christ centered program that can offer new insights to assist in healing. Each week we meet to view a helpful video on grief related topics, and follow up with a group discussion time. Those two parts, plus the use of a personal reflection guidebook, can help participants discover ways to move on and make progress in this journey.

The fourth 13-week cycle of GriefShare was completed on April 7<sup>th</sup> here at FCC. During this cycle, we averaged 7 participants each week who ranged from high school age to their 60s. We are planning a start date for the next cycle on January 12, 2026, which will run through mid-April on Mondays evenings from 6-8pm. There will be 2 special sessions of Surviving the Holidays on November 15 and December 13. These will be 2 hours each session from 10am to noon. More details will come as we get closer to the holidays. Please keep these dates in mind to share with friends or family that you feel may benefit from gathering together to help navigate their grief.

There is a real need for people willing to assist with group discussions. The ideal group size is 3-4 individuals, any one that is willing or able to assist should contact either Rita Baker or Cal Gale. You can also find more information online at [GriefShare.org](http://GriefShare.org).



## UGANDA

**Our church is planting and sowing seeds in Uganda - both literally and figuratively.**

The Ofu Loso ministry has been working diligently to bring the Gospel into the refugee settlements in the Adjumani district. With a desire to provide food during the trainings, they were able to secure the use of some land but didn't have the funds for seed. Faith Community mission funds supplied the funds for corn and bean seed which will hopefully provide a bountiful harvest - food during the pastoral trainings in the refugee settlements with any extra being sold to provide other necessary supplies.



**Prayer request for our Ofu Loso family in Uganda:**

- Pray for a bountiful harvest of beans & corn in the fields so people may be physically nourished.
- Pray for the ears to hear and an harvest of new believers in the Adjumani refugee settlements.

## BIBLES

Mission Funds were also used to provide Bibles in both the English and the local language of Achouli to Pastor Edwin Onen and Kitgum Bible Community Church located in Kitgum, Uganda. New believers in the churches' discipleship groups LOVED receiving the precious gift of their very own Bibles. In addition to the Bibles, assistance was provided to make copies of the current discipleship materials used by Pastor Edwin.

### The Cheerful Giver

#### 2 Corinthians 9:6-9

**The point is this: whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. Each one must give as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that having all sufficiency in all things at all times, you may abound in every good work.**

**As it is written, "He has distributed freely, he has given to the poor; his righteousness endures forever."**


