OPENING PRAYER ICE BREAKER:

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Read the scripture for today

- 1. What are some wrong views of Jesus? How have you seen those views play put in people's lives?
- 2. Where in the Bible would you point to in order to explain who Jesus is?
- 3. What do you think of the sentence "Christianity is always personal but never private"?
- 4. When was the last time you were able to publicly profess Jesus to others? How did it go?
- 5. What did Jesus mean when he said "flesh and blood did not reveal this to you but my father who is in Heaven"?
- 6. What is the rock upon which Jesus promises to build his church?
- 7. What alternatives have you seen people try to build the church upon?
- 8. What are the keys to the kingdom?
- 9. How does 1 Peter 2 inform your understanding of your identity and mission?

APPLICATION

- 1. What is your nagging unanswered question?
- 2. What did you want to hear that you didn't hear from the message?
- 3. How can we get to know God as He is and not in the limited way we do now?
- 4. Think about what most caught your attention in the text or discussion. Why is God catching your attention with this at this point in your life? What does God want you to know or do?
- 5. What's one thing from this text that you could say to a believer/unbeliever about who God is?

PRAYER

Ask people for specific prayer requests. Pray for needs and for applications of the text. Ask for volunteers who would like to pray for those people and requests.

SHEPHERDING

Check the roster and see who is not there. Does the group know why someone is not there? Are there needs that can be meet by the group? Specific prayer requests? Ask for someone to reach out and say, "We missed you."
